





Questions and Answers with Sheree K. Nielsen & Pat Wahler

What made you decide to write Midnight the One-Eyed Cat?

The story, inspired by Sheree's cat Midnight, and a dream Sheree had about a one-eyed cat with a feather in her hat, came to fruition after Sheree penned a poem and phoned Pat to brainstorm about creating a picture book. The tale of *Midnight the One-Eyed Cat*, conveys important messages for children about friendship, self-assurance and facing one's fears. Together, our hope is that every child spreads the news that with a little love and courage, you can conquer all of life's problems.

Both of you have other published works. How did the process of writing a picture book compare with your previous writing?

Writing a children's picture book is a different project than any other work we have penned in the past. In a collaboration, each author must be flexible and take the other's writing style and ideas into consideration to fulfill the end product — a book to make both of us proud.

What would you like readers to take away from reading your book?

The main message of the book is that children are okay just the way they are, no matter their differences. Every child is beautiful and unique.

Do you have plans to write more children's books?

We have been brainstorming new animal characters – furry and feathered, to share other important and topical messages for children. Sheree has been working on her essay collection, *Ocean Rhythms*, *Kindred Spirits* – An Emerson-inspired essay collection on travel, nature, family and pets, due out this fall. Pat has been working on a collection of Christmas-focused essays, poems, and short stories, *Let Your Heart Be Light*, due out this fall.

Questions and Answers with Sheree K. Nielsen & Pat Wahler

What should readers know about you?

SHEREE K. NIELSEN: The wanderlust bug bit me as a toddler when my parents traveled annually in May to the Florida Keys and the Carolinas, and every August to the Great Lakes. Drop me on a beach and I'm happy! As an artist and photographer, I've dabbled in both creative forms since I was a young child. For the last 9 years, I've been lucky to write for major travel publications. Serving as a youth sponsor at my church, I enjoyed mentoring teenagers on life's issues. I love being with nature and have rescued fur babies for the last 30+ years.

PAT WAHLER: I've always had a heart for rescue animals, and in the past have worked with my local humane society by fostering special needs animals and serving on the board of directors. My current critters are both rescues – one "Mama's boy" pup and a tabby with an attitude. I'm a former children's librarian, Juvenile Officer, and grant writer. Sort of an odd but interesting combination of hats to wear, right?






